



# Second Melbourne Sea Slug Census

**Friday 12 - Monday 15 October 2018**

Using your underwater camera, collect images of Sea Slugs anywhere in Port Phillip Bay, Western Port Bay and surrounds!

If you're out and about in the area we want to know what you find. It's up to you how you find them, but always remember to follow safe diving, snorkelling and rock pooling practices.

## Census Suggestions

1. Photos for the census are to be taken within Port Phillip Bay, Western Port Bay and surrounds, between **00:01am Friday 12 October 2018 – 23:59 Monday 15 October 2018**.
2. Send in **one photo for each species** of sea slug you encounter on census weekend. You don't need to identify the slugs (although please do if you can), just take their photos!
3. Photos should be cropped around the slug, shrunk to around 640x480 pixels, and submitted by email or Dropbox to [melbourneseaslugcensus@gmail.com](mailto:melbourneseaslugcensus@gmail.com) by **Sunday 21 October**.
4. Emails should include the names of everyone involved in capturing the image and details of the location where photos were taken. If you collect images at more than one site please indicate which photos were taken at which site. For a photo to be considered, it must be named as:

**Photographer Name\_Location\_Sea Slug name (if known)\_Date**

There will be prizes up for grabs for the best photo and most unusual species caught on camera!
